Camp Programs

Single Day Camp

Single Day camps are a one day, fun filled themed camp. From 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. you and your Cub Scouts will enjoy swimming, archery, BB gun, crafts, games and adventure. You have six sessions to choose from this summer.

Cub Overnight

While at the Cub Overnight, campers spend 2 days and 1 night. On the first day you will arrive around 8:00 a.m., get to settle in, enjoy a day of fun activities, experience a fantastic campfire by our staff. The next day will be full of exciting activities, and you will be on your way home by 5:00 p.m. There are three sessions to choose from this year.

Webelos Camp

Gamehaven welcomes Scouts entering Webelos I and Webelos II to a four day, three night camping adventure. On the first day you will arrive around 2:00 p.m. get to settle in, do swim checks, experience fun activities and enjoy a fantastic campfire by our staff. While enjoying the pool, archery range, BB-gun range, canoe and kayak program, and obstacle course, the Scouts will have a chance to earn activity pins and work on advancement. Families are encouraged to come out for lunch at noon on the last day of camp and join the Scouts for the closing campfire. Expect things to wrap up about 1:45 p.m. Five themed sessions are offered this year.

The Webelos Camp also offers an Outpost overnight experience for Webelos II so they can have a “Boy Scout” camping experience. The Webelos will have the opportunity to pitch their own tents, cook their own meals and do other activities to prepare them for their camping experiences as a Boy Scouts. We ask that you pre-register for any boys and adults attending the outpost. Please use the Outpost column on the registration form to sign your Scouts up.

Aquatics Day Camp (NEW!!)

This fun, new camp program is open to all Cub Scouts who want to spend more time in and around the water! From 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. Scouts will get to enjoy swimming as well as canoeing / kayaking and fishing which is not offered at the single day camp.

Webelos Adventure Day Camp (NEW!!)

This new camp program is designed for Webelos I and II who are looking to complete more pins at summer camp. **With the exception of Aquanaut and Outdoorsman, the pins offered at this camp are different than those offered at the Webelos Overnight camp.** From 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. Scouts will have the opportunity to complete an additional two pins and also enjoy free time to participate in their favorite camp activities including swimming, so be sure to bring your swim trunks!
