



GSR Youth Deer Hunt Shotgun or Muzzleloader

Sponsored by Gamehaven Council & the MN DNR



Eligible Youth Include:

- Registered Gamehaven Council Boy Scouts & Venturing Crew Scouters
- Young Men and Young Women 14-16 years of age (or 13 AND in 9th grade)

Boy Scouts of America does not condone hunting as a Boy Scout activity; however, Venturers may participate in hunts. Due to this Safe Scouting restriction, Venturing Crew# 0199 was created for this program which is sponsored by Gander Mountain. A Boy Scout will need to register with the Crew to be eligible for the hunt. He can have dual membership in his Troop and this Crew for no extra cost. All applicants who are drawn in the lottery will need to register into the Crew at Orientation.

Selection for this hunt will be by lottery with preference given to novice hunters.

Requirements to Hunt:

- Must have Firearms Safety Certificate. MUST Include MNDNR # on Hunt Application.
- A Scout must hunt with a parent, guardian, or appointed mentor, in addition to a GSR Guide for a hunting party of three.

Dates of the Hunt:

Sat & Sun October 9-10, 2010 or
Sat & Sun October 23-24, 2010

MANDATORY Orientation:

Sunday, October 3, 2010 @ Deer Lodge/Shelter 2

This orientation is mandatory for the hunting Scouts and their parents. If the parent is not hunting with their son or daughter, the Scout's guardian or mentor must accompany the Scout and parent to Orientation as well. In addition, the hunting Guides will be present at this orientation.

If a Scout misses the Orientation for any reason, he or she will be disqualified from the hunt. No exceptions.

Application deadline 5:00pm August 13, 2010. Applications must be received in the Council Office 1124 11 1/2 St. SE Rochester, MN 55904 by the deadline. Applications received after August 13, 2010 will not be eligible for the lottery.

- **Only successfully drawn applicants will be notified by mail.**
- **There will be 7 hunters drawn for each weekend (14 total) and 4 alternates.**
- **Scouts will be notified if they are 1st Round hunters or alternates.**
- **Alternates, their parent, and their hunting partner (if not their parent) will be required to attend the Orientation as well.**
- **Selected applicants will be posted on the Council Website by their Firearm Safety Number.**
- **Successfully drawn applicants will be notified by Monday, August 23, 2010.**
