

**Ten Commandments Hike
Saturday, October 30, 2010
Registration Form**



Thank you for your interest in the **Ten Commandments Hike** in Rochester, Minnesota. The Hike route takes participants to ten houses of worship. At each stop participants will hear a short presentation about one of the Ten Commandments, a bit about that faith group and the worship area, and be able to ask questions. This will be an opportunity for Boy Scouts and Cub Scouts, third grade and older, to share an experience demonstrating their **Duty to God**.

Registration begins September 2 and ends October 30, the day of the Hike, or when 200 participants are registered.

- A few notes:
- Wear your uniforms. **No** shorts!
- You may bring your flags, but *you* will have the honor of carrying them for the distance.
- The 2.5-mile Hike (including lunch break) will last approximately six hours, from 9:00 – 3:00.
- The Hike will proceed whatever the weather, so “Be Prepared.”
- The Hike will begin at St. John’s Catholic Church, 11 Fourth Ave SW, Rochester, MN. Use the school entrance on the north side.
- Parking is available in the Lourdes parking lot, between 6th & 7th Aves NW and 1st & 2nd Sts NW. **Do not park in the north east corner of the parking lot, marked “Reserved for Mayo Clinic.”**
- Registration or check-in is between 8:15 and 8:45.
- Register or check in once all your unit participants are present.
- At the registration or check-in tables, one adult/unit should
 - Register or check in at the designated table,
 - Pay fees with one unit or personal check,
 - Receive all information and instructions for the Hike.
- The Hike fee is \$4.00/participant, due either with registration or at check-in, the day of the Hike. The fee includes the patch, Hike permit, insurance, paper and printing.
- Carry your sack lunch and drink in a backpack along with any other “gear” you might need (rain gear, etc.).
- Youth Protection Guidelines must be followed. An individual Scout may participate with a parent. A pack, den, troop, patrol or crew may participate as a group with a minimum of two registered leaders, or one registered leader and a parent. Leaders must have their youth and adult medical forms in their possession.
- Boy Scout troops and Venture Crews may want to include camping at GSR Friday and/or Saturday night. Check the availability of space at the Council Service Center.
