Re: Spring Council of Chiefs Meeting

As many of you know, the Spring Council of Chiefs Meeting is fast approaching. The Council of Chiefs will be held April 10-11, 2010 at L.E. Phillips Scout Reservation in Haugen, WI. The address is 2900C 16th Street Rice Lake, WI 54868. Exit US 53 at hwy V, go through Haugen, then take VV right to camp.

The meeting will officially start at 10:15 on Saturday, meals will be provided through Sunday morning. The cost for the weekend will be \$20.00 for all participants. The fee will cover our food for the weekend as well as other expenses. Since a couple lodges are planning to do their LAP visits Friday night, we will be serving dinner Friday night between 6:30pm and 9:00pm and breakfast Saturday morning around 8:30am. All participants are invited to come up and stay Friday night if they wish. Arrowmen may stay either in the heated Winter Camp buildings or the tent cabins for the weekend, whichever they prefer.

With that said, participants should remember to bring: a sleeping bag and pillow, other camping equipment, a full Boy Scout Uniform (Class A), an OA sash, a notebook and writing utensil(s), CoC materials, personal toiletries. Participants may also want to bring their OA handbook. Notice our agenda includes a camp tour, so bring appropriate clothing and footwear for the weather.

During the C.O.C each lodge will give an update to the Section, similar to the one given in January. Please make these presentations thorough but less than 5 minutes in length. You may use a PowerPoint to enhance your presentation if you wish, and plan to touch on which activities your lodge plans to run at the conclave (i.e. ultimate Frisbee, patch auction etc.). Also as a reminder, in addition to the lodges' Key 3, the Council of Chiefs is open to any lodge leaders interested in Section operations.

Each lodge should contact the Section Adviser, Dick Amelse, by April 2 to notify him how many plan to attend, with ages if under 21, and when they plan to arrive so the food may be purchased.

Directions to Camp Phillips

L.E. Phillips Scout Reservation is located in North-western Wisconsin, northwest of Rice Lake. To get to camp, take Highway 53 to Haugen, Wisconsin. Turn West off of Highway 53 onto County Road V. Follow County Road V through Haugen to Plecity Avenue. Turn right on Plecity Avenue and go to the stop sign at County Road VV. Turn left onto County Road VV. Continue on County Road VV for 3 miles until you reach Camp Phillips.
