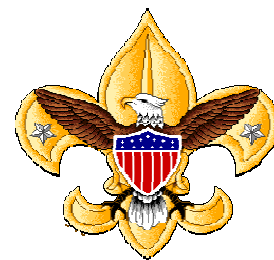
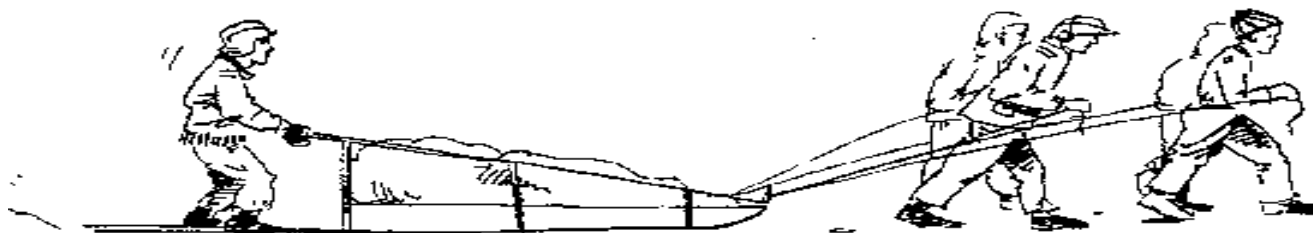




Get Ready for the 2011 Hiawatha District Klondike Derby

When: Check in Friday, February 11, 2011 starting at 6:00 p.m. if staying overnight through Saturday, February 12, 2011 until 8:30 p.m.
Saturday February 12th 2011 - check in and sled inspection between 8:15 & 8:45.

Where: Gamehaven Scout Reservation

Who: Boy Scout Patrols (6-8 boys per patrol sled are ideal)

Equipment Needed:

- **Per Patrol:** Klondike sled loaded with materials to demonstrate first class rank advancement skills in whipping and outdoor winter environment. Extra points achieved in the skill competition when you only use materials carried on the sled or readily available. Here are some suggested materials, but this is not a complete list: patrol flag, compass, first aid kit, scout handbook, pocket knife, fire building materials with no chemical accelerants, rope for lashing, matches and flint and steel, blanket, ground cloth, rope for tying knots, twisted rope splicing.
- **Per Scout:** Spoon, cup, warm clothing including layers, hat, gloves, multiple pairs of socks, and waterproof boots. Also, bring a can of soup for the mixed soup hot lunch.
- **Program:** Scouts will push or pull their sled throughout the day while enjoying competitive skill stations, learning stations, a hot lunch and hot drinks, a great sled race, and a bonfire with patrol skits and songs, awards, and closing ceremony. Some of the skills tested may include first aid, nature identification, map and compass navigation, knots and ropes, fire building, water rescue, winter preparedness and survival, physical fitness, and teamwork. Scouts will be judged at each event on their skill knowledge and preparedness.
- **Station Leaders:** All scouting events survive by the help of troop volunteers. No preparation or previous experience needed to help out. Materials and instruction provided. Your help is greatly appreciated by all. **Scoutmaster's meeting** Friday, February 11th, 2011 8:30 PM. **SPL meeting** at 9:00 PM. Locations to be announced.
