Camping Choices: On your own (You Choose and bring what you need)

Heated tent (Limited to 30 scouts)

High Adventure – These scouts will spend their day building their shelters (snow cave, lean to, ect) and spend the night in them

Cold Weather Training: Cold weather injuries, How to Dress (COLD) to stay warm, How to stay warm when you are sleeping and Shelters.
